
Pursuant to Iowa R. Civil P. 1.443, Respondent State of Iowa moves for additional time to file a responsive pleading herein. In support of its motion, Respondent submits the following:

1. Petitioner's petition was filed and served June 6, 2011.
2. A responsive pleading is now due on or before June 27, 2011.
3. The petition raises issues which require legal research prior to preparation of a responsive pleading.
4. Respondent's undersigned counsel represents, among other agencies, the Iowa Board of Pharmacy which meets June 28-29, 2011. Seven contested case hearings are scheduled for the June 28-29<sup>th</sup> Pharmacy Board meeting. Preparation for the meeting and the contested cases will prevent counsel from performing the research necessary to support a responsive pleading until after the June 28-29<sup>th</sup> Pharmacy Board meeting.
5. Respondent's counsel has contacted Petitioner to obtain his consent to a 30 day extension of time, to and including July 27, 2011, in which to file a responsive pleading. Petitioner Carl Olsen does not object to the proposed extension of time.

WHEREFORE, Respondent-State of Iowa requests an order allowing Respondent an additional 30 days – through July 27, 2011 – in which to serve a responsive pleading herein.
